

The Look & Listen test checklist

Spot leaks early and prevent them from damaging your home with the Look & Listen test.

Leaks can appear anywhere in your home, but the biggest leaks can be found in

- Taps
- Toilets
- Tanks



When should you check for home leaks?

- Check regularly for leaks [e.g. once a week]
- Wait until it's quiet [e.g. at night] to make it easier to listen out for leaks



Use the checklist below to use the Look & Listen test in your home:

Look

- Damp patches on your ceilings, walls or floors
- Discolouration marks or peeling wallpaper on your walls
- Unexpected increases to your water bill

- Signs of mould

Listen

- Constant dripping of water
- Continuous flow of running water
- Toilet bowl is constantly refilling
- Noisy toilet cistern, once flushed
