Clay Farm



We ran two sessions with Aquality, where they showed us their rainwater harvesting systems at Clay Farm in Cambridge. Clay Farm is a housing development of 208 homes and commercial accommodation with the system supplying all toilets in the development through a dedicated non-potable water pipe network. What is a NAV?

New appointments and variations [NAVs] are limited companies who can be appointed to provide a water and/ or sewerage service to customers in an area which was previously provided by the incumbent monopoly provider.

These companies are appointed by Ofwat and have the same duties and responsibilities as any other statutory water company.

Within the Affinity Water region we have seen a 380% increase in NAV sites since 2050, so it is important for our project to help new entrants into the market.
